# Nominate pavements for repair

Residents concerned about the condition of pavements in their local area can now nominate them for repair.

In our local Residents' Survey, people highlighted that the condition of pavements was among their top concerns. In response, the Council has made £500k (£35k per village) available in 2017/18 specifically to pay for community nominated improvements.

This round of funding is now open for residents to nominate pavements they feel are in need of extra work, in the area where they live.

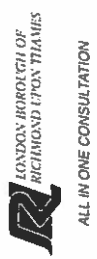
Funding will be directed to pavements that receive the most nominations and fulfil the greatest community need.

In the last round of nominations in 2016, over 1,300 people took part and many neighbours joined forces to suggest repairs in their local area. Each of the fourteen village areas in the borough will receive £35k. This funding is in addition to the annual pavement repair fund delivered by the Council.
