

Game Title: Making a Path for Teddy

How to play: cut out the digit cards and place all of them onto the table or floor. Point to each number and say the name of each number. Order the numbers from smallest to biggest. Can teddy jump along the number path (forwards and backwards), saying the numbers to check they are in the correct order.

Resources included: 1 instruction card, 1 set of digit cards (8-17) to cut out.

Resources needed from home: scissors, one small teddy.

Key skills involved in this game: Ordering numbers across the 10 boundary, counting forwards and backwards, recognising numerals.

Vocabulary/ key questions to ask: Order... Count... One more... One less than...

Extra for experts: Place teddy on a number, can you say the number that comes before or after the number?
