

Game Title: Dominoes

How to play: Cut out the domino cards and lay all of the dominoes out on a flat surface. Create a path with the dominoes by counting the number of dots on one end of a domino and then placing it next to another domino with the amount of dots one more or one less than that number. For example a domino with four dots can go beside a domino with three dots or five dots.

Resources included: 1 dominoes template to cut out, 1 instruction card.

Resources needed from home: scissors

Key skills involved in this game: Say the number that comes before or after a given number within the sequence 0-30.

Vocabulary/key questions to ask: More...Less...What number comes just after/before?

Extra for experts: Can you tell a partner which domino is first, second, third, fourth, fifth in your path.
