

Game Title: **Number Snap**

How to play: Cut out the number cards and shuffle them. With a partner separate the cards into two even piles and take one pile each. Lay the cards in a pile upside down in front of you. Take turns to turn over one card each and place it onto a pile in the middle. If two numbers the same are placed on top of each other call 'snap' and place your hand over the pile of cards. The person who is first to place their hand over the cards and call 'snap' gets to add all of the cards in the middle to their pile.

Resources included: number cards template to cut out, 1 instruction card.

Resources needed from home: scissors.

Key skills involved in this game: Recognise numerals 0-30.

Vocabulary/key questions to ask: Numbers – 100, same.

Extra for experts: Play snap calling 'snap' when the card placed on top is one more or one less than the number below it.
