

## Game Title: **Three in a Row**

**How to play:** Sit the game board between you and partner. Each choose which colour of counters you would like to be. Take turns to roll the two dice and add together the total number of dots. Place one of your counters on top of that number on the game board. The first person to get three of their counters in a row wins the game.

**Resources included:** 1 game board to print, counter template, 1 instruction card.

**Resources needed from home:** two dice (or create one by writing the numbers 1-6 on the cube template).

**Key skills involved in this game:** Find the total by combining two groups.

**Vocabulary/key questions to ask:** together, add, count, total, how many altogether?

**Extra for experts:** See if you can roll two dice and take away the smaller number from the larger number.
