

# Game Title: Book Tally

**How to play:** Keep a tally chart of how many books you read/are read to you each day of the week Monday–Friday. On Friday see if you can create a simple graph by printing off the template of the graph and drawing/stamping/using stickers for the right amount of books that you read each day. How many books did you read each day? Which day did you read the most/least books?

**Resources included:** 1 instruction card, graph template

**Resources needed from home:** books to read, paper and pens, printed template of graph

**Key skills involved in this game:** keeping a simple tally, creating a simple picture graph, counting.

**Vocabulary/key questions to ask:** how many books did you read on...? Most, least, more than, less than, total.

**Extra for experts:** Can you write the number of books that you read each week? Can you add up how many books that you read on Tuesday and Friday/ Monday and Wednesday? Can you add up how many books that you read altogether this week?
