Learning Theme Title: India

Overview

The focus of this theme is to learn about the main religions and the physical and human geography of India. In **art** children will be creating their own Divali pots using clay. In **design technology** children will be making Parothas (Indian Pancakes). In **geography** children will use maps to establish where India is, use climate data to solve the location of mystery areas and use secondary sources to investigate life in India.

- Developing geographical vocabulary
- Interpreting a range of climatic data (geography)
- Drawing comparisons between the children's own lives and those of children in India
- Use a range of resources to research and present key aspects of Hinduism
- Compare and contrast the key religions of India
- How to prepare filling ingredients for Indian Parathas using chopping, cutting and grating techniques (design and technology)
- To learn to use sculpturing techniques using clay (art and design)
