Learning how to stay safe online

- · a message pops up from someone we don't know.

We must keep our personal information safe by not sharing it with people we don't know. Personal information can include our full name, address, name of our school and phone number.

Staying safe online

Not everyone is who they say they are online.

We should not chat with people we don't know online.
