How to use search engines safely

We can use the internet for playing games, listening to music, sending messages, watching movies and finding information

When we search for information safely online we use a children's search engine (Swiggle, Kiddle, Gogglekids, KidRex).

If something goes wrong we minimise the page and tell an adult we trust.



Sending emails

Email means electronic mail – it is a popular way to send messages digitally.

Emails have 5 main parts: subject, greeting, message body, closing, signature.

We must proofread our email and check they have:

- a clear and specific subject line
- a greeting, closing and our name.
