material — the substance that an object is made from properties — the characteristics of materials eg rigid opaque — cannot be seen through transparent — completely seethrough absorbent - will hold water waterproof - resists water rigid - will not bend flexible – bendable soft — something that is easy to bend or shape - not firm or hard hard – not soft or firm

Some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.










Scientists:
