J2e5 - Blogging

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We must log in to the J2e website to access our work. To log in we click on our names and enter our password which have 4 digits. J2e5 can be used to create text and images which we can publish to share with others.

Our work can be saved on j2e so that we can retrieve it at a later time. To save our work we must click on the save symbol — it looks like this.



Some people enjoying interacting with others on blogs – these are online journals where stories or subjects can be shared with readers over weeks, months or years. Popular blogging services include Tumblr, WordPress and Blogger.

If you find yourself reading a blog you really enjoy, you can add comments and questions at the end of a story. In fact, most authors want readers to respond. You can start your own blog and share your experiences or passions with the rest of the world.

Bear in mind that once you post something online, you can't always take it back. Don't post comments, photos or videos that may cause embarrassment, and never post comments that may upset people or cause offence.
