

Adverbials: shortly, until now, from there, as a consequence, from where, immediately after that,

Some connecting adverbials:

Addition	also, furthermore, moreover
Opposition	however, nevertheless, on the other hand
Reinforcing	besides, anyway, after all
Explaining	for example, in other words, that is to say
Listing	first, first of all, finally
Indicating result	therefore, consequently, as a result
Indicating time	just then, meanwhile, later

Coordinating Conjunctions – these split the two clauses (there are seven):

for and nor but or yet so

Subordinating Conjunctions – these can appear at the beginning of a sentence or in the middle of two clauses (these are only a few):

after, although, as, as if, as long as, although, because, before, even if, even though, if, once, provided, since, so that, though, unless, until, when, whenever, wherever, whether, while

Relative Pronouns – these enable you to write relative clauses
