Key Facts and Knowledge

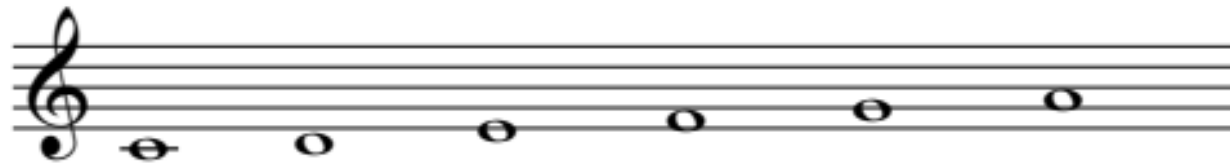
Melody is a series of notes of different lengths and pitch in an order.
