

In Y3, you start off writing entries in your KSI Reading Journal until spring term.

### Autumn term (in KSI journal)

You will be expected to have a book 'on the go' at all times. As well as at home, there are opportunities to read at school during some registration times and during guided reading.

What to do:

- Read **every day** for at least 10 minutes
- Complete at least **four entries** each week
- Try to **read out loud with an adult at home** as much as you can. They will be able to help you understand words you don't know and will be able to check you have understood what you have read.

Your teacher will look at your journal during class reading and guided reading lessons. **You will also need to hand in your reading journal on the set day.**

### Spring and summer term (in KS2 journal)

The same opportunities to read in school apply as above. The same applies to your hand in day and expectation for how long and how often you read. These tips explain how to log your reading in your new KS2 journal:

What to do:

- Write the **date, title of the book, and page number**
- When you **read with an adult, write 'A'** in the margin under the date
- In addition to the logged reading, **one extended entry** needs to be completed. Each week you will be given tasks to choose from.
