#### WHO HAS PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY?

- **mothers** have automatic parental responsibility for their children
- **fathers** (married or not) who are named on the birth certificate have automatic parental responsibility for their children
- other adults who may look after your child such as childminders or grandparents do not have parental responsibility but you can authorise them to make medical decisions for your child on your behalf, should you wish to do so.

**The Family and Parenting Institute** produce a leaflet called *Is it legal? A parents' guide to the Law*, which provides further information about parental responsibility and answers many frequently asked questions.

### Form Appendix D/ADHOC is used for:

- **antibiotics** 2 days of medication should ideally have been completed before the child returns to school, to counter any possible side effects
- any other short term **prescribed** medicines
- asthma (short term, viral and seasonal symptoms only)
- hay fever (short term, viral and seasonal symptoms only)
