KS2 Lunchtime Supervisor

Purpose of the post

• To supervise pupils in the dining hall and be responsible for their safety during lunchtime breaks.

Key tasks

- Supervising pupils at lunchtime
- encouraging them to eat healthily
- helping younger children to open packaging or cut up food
- providing some social training such as good table manners
- cleaning up spillages and wiping and sanitising tables between sittings
- maintaining order
- reporting unresolved problems to the relevant teacher or headteacher
