Where does the rain go?

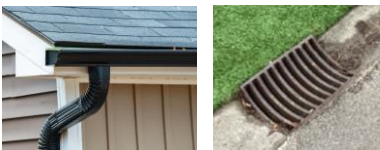
Rain falls from the sky.

Sometimes rain forms puddles.

Puddles get smaller in the sun as the water goes back up into the sky.

Some water **absorbs** into the soil which helps things grow.

Some water runs down into **drain pipes** or **gutters** and ends up in the sewers.
