PANTS,



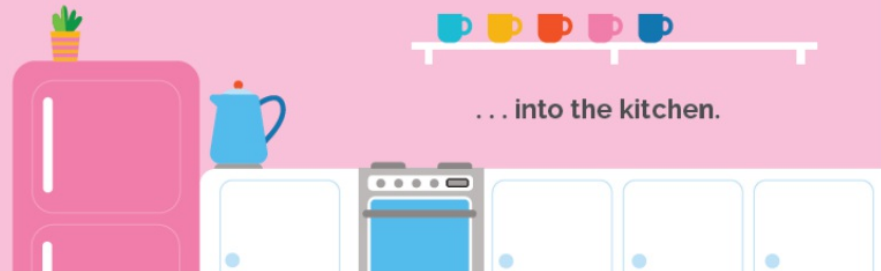
PANTS,
